This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 17.270 mills, an increase of 3.000 mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 14.270 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$120.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$75,000 is approximately \$90.00.
